

ADD NEW EVENT FOR SURFBOARD PADDLING RACES

100-Yard Race For Men Over 30 Years of Age Is Added To Program

A special event, a 100-yard race for men over 30 years of age, has been added to the program for the annual New Year's Day surfboard paddling contests to be staged at the Ala Wai January 1.

At a meeting of the general committee held at the Outrigger Canoe club a few days ago details of the program were discussed and it was announced that the show would probably be staged under the joint auspices of the Outrigger Canoe club and Dawkins, Benny.

The only new condition added to the regulations was that boards will be barred. It was also decided to enforce, as much as possible, the ruling that each competitor must use his or her own board.

The program will start promptly at 9:30 a. m. and the officials are organizing their work so that the events can be run off in a snappy manner.
