

Hui Nalu Team Wins Polo Tilt From Outrigger

First of Series of Surfboard Polo Games Played At Waikiki

The Hui Nalu surfboard paddlers defeated the Oturigger Canoe club in a surfboard water polo match at Waikiki beach yesterday. The score was 5-0.

The Hui Nalu "Blacks" and "Golds" battled to a scoreless tie in their match for the Wedel trophy.

The Hui Nalus, in the main game, scored four goals in the first half and added one in the second. The first goal came on a freak play when the wind caught the ball after it had been passed by "Buster" Crabbe, carrying the ball into the Outrigger goal for the first point scored by the Hui Nalus. Other goals were registered by Sargeant Kahanamoku and John De Kaupiko, Jr., each registering two.

Outstanding performers for the Outrigger were "Buster" Crabbe and Gay Harris, while Sam Kahana-moku, Sargeant Kahanamoku and Kaupiko were the star players for the victors.
