

OUTRIGGER CLUB REACHES MAJORITY

Annual Members' Day Is Gala Occasion on Wai- kiki Beach

The Outrigger club grounds were gay with pennants yesterday, and the beach was crowded with members and their guests assembled for the annual members' day. The club comes of age this year—it is 21 years old. Yesterday's celebration, however, was in observance of Washington's birthday as much as that of the club. The best steersmen of the outrigger canoes spent the day taking members out for rides in the surf. Brilliant weather and vigorous surf were ideal for that part of the program.

Between 6 and 7:30 o'clock 500 members and guests enjoyed one of the celebrated Outrigger chowder suppers. The lanai was decorated with palm leaves and hibiscus. One of the club's pioneers, Alexander Hume Ford, tested the chowder some time before, and his Llewellyn setter, returned returned to the fold, approved of the apple pie, of which he was given a helping. Pictures of the club's early days were shown after the supper, and Ford presented the club with a painting of the club building of 20 years ago by moonlight, the work of a famous marine landscape painter, W. A. Coulter.
