

HAROLD HARVEY RETURNING FROM VAUDEVILLE TOUR

Completing a vaudeville tour that took him all over the mainland and to London and Paris, Harold Harvey, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred E. Harvey, will return to Honolulu tomorrow on the Manoa, according to advices received last night.

Harvey is well known in athletic circles here. While at Punahou he starred with the Pun track team and later became assistant to Coach Jinky Crozier. He also coached the Outrigger track team.

Two years ago Harvey joined the Park Sisters, a vaudeville team that appeared at the Princess theater. With them he toured the mainland, playing the ukulele and singing. He appeared in practically all the principal cities, and then joined the Paris Revue of 1928, in Paris.
