

Aliiolani Swimmers Cop Honors In Fourth Annual Citywide Meet

Senate Wins From House In Special Event By Forfeiture; Borg Introduced To Youngsters; Ligda Hands Out Six Medals To Winners; Bessie Hemmings Star

When the lights went dim in the Waikiki natatorium last night, the star swimmers for the house got an attack of "cold feet" with the result that Francis H. I. Brown of the senate won the big splashing event by forfeiture.

Senator Brown was all "dolled" up to meet the best from the house and backed by Senators Henry Aki and Harold Rice was ready to lower a couple of world records if necessary. However, nobody from the house showed up.

In the other part of the meet, the fourth annual Citywide affair, the Aliiolani walked off with the honors, winning both convincingly and decisively.

Arne Borg, the "Terrible Swede," was introduced to the youngsters who gave him a big hand. Buster and Buddy Crabbe gave an exhibition in a medley race.

It was announced this morning that Bessie Hemmings of Aliiolani scored 25 points in the meet and won one of the six medals offered by Victor Ligda of McKinley swimming team. She will be rewarded with a gold medal. The 10-year-old girl from Aliiolani won five first places.

Bebe MacMullen, 7-year-old girl of Aliiolani, won second scoring honors with 20 points. She will be awarded a gold medal by Lig-

da. Olga Clarke, also of Aliiolani, and Tongo Tomita of Palama each scored 15 points and they will be given silver medals. J. MacMullen of Aliiolani and Elmo Tomita of Palama with 12 and eight points, respectively, win bronze medals.

Honorable mention goes to Mae Lanzebu, Josephine Hunter and Jean Smith.
