

ANNOUNCE LIST OF ENTRIES FOR RAINBOW RELAYS

Trials Will Be Held Today In Eight Events; Give Starting Times

Trials will be held at Kamehameha field at 4:30 p. m. today in eight of the events listed on the program for the Rainbow Relays.

The finals will be staged at Kamehameha field Saturday afternoon under the auspices of the University of Hawaii. Otto Klum of the University, in charge of arrangements for the meet, received the final entries last night and today announced the complete list. He also gave the records for various events and the list of starting times.

The entries show that more teams will compete in the relay events than in past seasons and indications are that competition will be very keen. Due to the large number of entries trials will be held in the following events: 100-yard dash, 220-yard hurdles, broad jump, high jump, pole vault, discus and javelin.
