

# DETAILED ACCOUNT OF OPENING SWIMS

The 100-meter breaststroke for Service opened the evening's program. After a neck and neck race throughout, L. Ryan, Harbor Defense, nosed out M. Alsup, swimming under the same colors. Novitski, also of the Harbor Defense, was third. The time was 1:32 4-5 seconds.

Another brilliant race followed, the 100-meters freestyle for boys under 15. First honors went to Melvin Paoa, swimming unattached. B. Koseki of Palama finished second, scarcely a yard behind Paoa. The time was 1:10 1-5 seconds.

Although thirteen local stars signed for the event, for some unknown reason, two swimmers, Manuella Kalili and Johnny Fortune, both prodigies of Harvey Chilton, veteran Hui Makani coach, reported for the start. The two Hui Makani lads put on an excellent show. Johnny Fortune led Kalili throughout by from five to seven yards but a driving finish gave the latter the race by some three yards. Kalili's time was 2 minutes, 19 seconds.

A 100-yard surfboard race for men, a special event on the program to illustrate the great speed that can be attained by the local beach boys in life saving, followed on the pro-

gram. Fred "Boy" Paoa of the Hui Makani club was first, Blake of the Outrigger club second, and D. Hollinger of the Queen's Surfriders third. The time was 35 4-5 seconds. This is a new record for the event, the old mark being 40 4-5 seconds.

The next event on the program, the 100-meter backstroke for boys under 18, went to Kapua Harris of the Central Y. M. C. A. Manuella Kalili of Hui Makani finished second. N. Kusunoki of Central "Y" came in third. The time was 1:18 2-5 seconds.

## GARATTI CRASHES RECORD

Eleanor Garatti of San Rafael who clipped 3-5 of a second off her own world's record in the trials in the afternoon, returned to the pool last night scarcely five hours later for the finals. A little over a minute later, Miss Garatti cut her mark down another 1-5 second.

Miss Eleanor Garatti of San Rafael, world's record holder for the 100 meter freestyle, lowered her own record for the 100-meters freestyle, negotiating the distance in 1 minute, 9 4-5 seconds. Miss Garatti reported to the starting mark with Albina
