They feel that the "cigar" board is in a class by itself when it comes to speed, and also understand that the balsam board is faster than the usual boards used and owned by the surfers. The balsam boards were barred at the fifth annual races last year. The sponsors have only one desire, and that is that everyone have an opportunity to compete fairly for the honors in the various races.

### Officials Asked

Club officials of the various beach clubs are invited to be present at this meeting and state their views and cooperate in arriving at the best decision relative to the kind of boards to be used. There will be just this one meeting so officials of clubs should be sure to be present Sunday morning.

The sponsors are holding this meeting well in advance so that any rules laid down may be well known, and the competitors given a chance to adjust their training to these rules.

The meeting will not go into any of the other details as the arrangements are all very well established and smooth running as a result of the holding of these championships in former years.
