

M⁷GILLIVRAY WINS FIFTY-YARD SWIM

Fails, However, To Touch Duke
Kahanamoku's Open Water
Or Tank Records

CHICAGO, April 4— (Associated Press)—Perry M. McGillivray, who is now at the Great Lakes Training Station, won the fifty-yard National A. A. U. championship swim here last night, his time being 24 4-5.

Norman Ross, the San Francisco Olympic Club entry, swam in the preliminaries but failed to qualify for the final heat.

Duke Kahanamoku's record for the distance remains unbeaten. Here it is: 50 yards, open tidal salt water, straightaway—23s., Duke P. Kahanamoku, Hui Nalu, Honolulu, H. T., June 11, 1915 (swimmer not aided by the tide; bath (100 feet), one turn—23 2-5s. Duke P. Kahanamoku, San Francisco, August 6, 1913.
