The Waikiki Athletic Club, Twentyfifth Infantry, Outrigger Canoe Club, and Hondulu Athletic Club are said to be out already keenly on the scent of this trophy.

The entries and order in which they will be run off are as follows:

100-yard dash, trials; mile run; 120yard hurdles, trials; 60-yard dash, trials; 200-yard midget relay race, four boys to each team; Boy Scouts Antelone race, four entries to each team; 220yard low hurdles, trials; 880-yard run; 400-yard Boys' Club relay race, four entries to each elub; 220-yard dash, trials; 440-yard dash: pole vault; putting sixteen-pound shot; running high jump; throwing sixteen-pound hammer; running broad jump; discus throw; howing javelin; five-mile run; halfmile relay race, four men to each team.
