

ISLAND SWIMMERS MAKE GOOD SHOWIN

Krueger Beats Duke In Handicap Event and Lane Finishes First In Open Match

U E W Y O R K, August 11—(Associated Press)—Swimmers from Honolulu finished second and third in the 880-yard vent, first and second in the 110-yard handicap and first in the 110-yard open in the swimming meet yesterday afternoon. Kahanamoku finished second to his team mate Krueger in the handicap event.

William L. Wallen, who won the open championship in the half mile last year repeated the performance yesterday making a new record for the 880 yards. He lowered the mark set by Norman Ross in Honolulu last September by two fifths of a second finishing in eleven minutes, twenty-seven and one fifth seconds. Ludy Langer was a close second.

In the 110-yard handicap Krueger, with eight seconds allowance on Kahanamoku managed to finish ahead of the Hawaiian who passed all the other contestants.

In the 110 yards open event Clarence Lane finished first.
