The previous time was one minute eight and two-fifths seconds for a tank held by Mc-Gilivray and the open water time was a minute and thirteen seconds held by C. R. Durgan.

Just how much of a handicap was given the message does not state, but evidently it was one that was fair enough to make the Duke exert himself to overcome.
