

DUKE KAHANAMOKU EASILY DEFEATS NEW YORK CRACK

NEW YORK, N. Y., Aug. 14.—

Duke Kahanamoku, Hawaiian short distance champion swimmer, won a hollow victory in the hundred yards swim last night, set the crowd wild and equalled his own record for the distance. It was the most marvelous exhibition for the distance the East has ever seen.

Allowing Alfred Steen of Brooklyn, who finished second, a handicap of nine yards, the tall Hawaiian got away with the crack of the pistol and swam at a pace that left all behind him. Well up toward the finish he caught Steen and finished a clear two yards ahead. Time 54 seconds.
