

HAWAIIAN STARS SHOW UP DANDY AT SPRINGFIELD

SPRINGFIELD, Mass.—Some very fast swimming was done by the Hawaiian swimmers in their exhibition at Riverside Park Thursday night. Lane, world's champion in short distances, swam 5 yards against Fred Peterson, a local Y. M. C. A. star, in 22 2-5 seconds.

Kahanamoku, racing 100 yards with Joseph Levens, who had a 7 second handicap, covered the distance in 50 4-5 seconds. These marks are better than the world's records, but cannot stand as official records because the course was not officially marked off.

Kruger, swimming the backstroke, defeated Otto Paris, swimming the crawl in a 50-yard race. Kruger's time was 29 2-5 seconds.
