HONOLULU SWIMMERS MAKE NEW RECORDS

BELMAN, N. J., Aug. 18.—In the 440-yard back-stroke invitation swim last night, Harold Kruger of Honolulu defeated Leo Glebel of New York, clipping two seconds from the world's record of 6:30.

Duke Kahanamoku, the Hawaiian swimmer, won the 200-yard event in the new record time of 2:13 3-5.

Miss Eleanor Uhl of Philadelphia won the 220-yard handicap for women, and Miss Olga Dorfner, also of Philadelphia, captured the 100-yard event in 1:08 2-5.
