

DUKE ORDERED INTO SERVICE

Local draft board No. 1 today issued a list of 31 registrants of both the 1917 and 1918 classes who have been ordered to report at the board headquarters, armory, at 9 o'clock on the morning of October 30 for induction into military service.

In the list of names is that of Duke P. Kahanamoku, Hawaii's famous swimmer, who recently completed a tour of the mainland with other aquatic stars for the benefit of the Red Cross. Kahanamoku recovered recently from an attack of influenza, and is reported to be on his way back to Honolulu.
