

DUKE'S INDUCTION ORDER CANCELED: TAKES POSITION WITH PUBLIC WORKS DEPT.

Following out instructions received last week from the provost marshal general, Capt. Clarence H. Cooke, chairman of local draft board No. 1, on Saturday canceled the induction order of Duke Kahanamoku, champion swimmer, who returned to Honolulu recently from a mainland tour for the benefit of the Red Cross.

Kahanamoku, when drafted, was on the mainland recovering from influenza. He left for Honolulu as soon as he was able to travel.

He reported to local board No. 1 on Saturday and was informed that his induction order had been canceled. This morning he joined the staff of the department of public works as a rodman.
