

Rescuer Must Be Rescued As Duke's Outrigger Capsizes

A miniature ship-wreck in which the rescuer had to be rescued was staged yesterday afternoon about 2:30 o'clock at Waikiki beach, when a big outrigger canoe in which were Duke Kahanamoku and a party of friends capsized outside the reef.

David Kahanamoku, his brother, seeing Duke's predicament, went to the rescue and took on some of the passengers of the capsized outrigger, but was blown out to sea in the stiff offshore breeze. A second "rescue party" consisting of the crew of the yacht Hawaii cruising in the vicinity with Dad Center in charge stood by to offer aid, and the two parties of "survivors" were brought ashore.
