

DOLE AND HALL TIE IN 20-YARD EVENT

Veteran Swimmers Center of Feature Aquatic Race In Y. M. C. A. Tank

Judge Sanford B. Dole, the first president of the Honolulu Y. M. C. A. in 1869, swam against William G. Hall, now president of the Y. M. C. A. in 1919, in the feature race of the evening at the anniversary meet held in the "Y" tank last evening. Both men swam the 20-yard dash in the fast time of 13 2-5 seconds.

President Hall took a slight lead in diving off at the crack of the starter's gun. Using a crawl stroke, Judge Dole held his own up to the middle of the tank. From this point on, he gained a little and, just before the 20-yard mark, put on a burst of speed and touched the end of the tank even with President Hall. Both men were given an ovation when the time was announced.

Diving Stunts Good

The diving exhibition by Bob Fuller, Lorrin P. Thurston and Jack Hiorth, was excellent. Diving from a new springboard, each did his best stunts in form. In the high dive, they made a perfect triple spring and struck the water as one man. A flood light was thrown on as each of the trio did his solo diving.

Bert Tarleton and son Colby featured in the double deck novelty race. Fuller and Thurston finished second. The novelty chase was one of the funniest events ever seen in local swimming circles. A wild duck was thrown into the tank with six boys after it. The duck carried off the honors and repeatedly eluded his pursuers by graceful diving at the critical moments.

McKinley High won the Interscholastic relay race in the fast time of 3 minutes 11 1-5 seconds for 320 yards, each man swimming 80 yards. Lorrin P. Thurston took the 100-yard swim in 59 seconds. Salphina Sandal won the midgets' race with Annie Phillips second. Albert Minvielle took the 220-yard swim.
