

YOUNG AND OLD SWIMMERS SHOW IN Y. M. C. A. MEET

The "50th anniversary" swimming meet of the Central Y. M. C. A. was pulled off in fine style Saturday night at the "Y" tank, in which some of the city's youngest natators and oldest water splashers featured the evening's program. Judge Sanford B. Dole, one of the charter members of the Y. M. C. A. and who is around the 80's, swam a dead heat with W. G. Hall, president of the central association, in a 20-yard swim, both men breasting the tape in 13 2-5, which was considered fast time.

Bob Fuller, Jack Hjorth, Lorrin A. Thurston, three of Honolulu's best divers, performed a number of excellent fancy dives which brought the fans to their toes. Standing on three springboards, the three-in-one performance of the once and a half was good. The interscholastic relay race was won by McKinley high, the team leading the Normal school team which came second by three-fourths of the length of the tank. The midget race was won by Salphina Sandal and the 220 yard swim was won by Albert Minvielle.

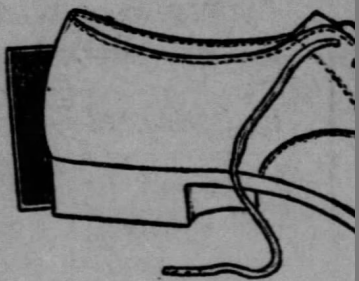
