Waikiki beach is at the end of its rope!

Lyman H. Bigelow, chairman of the harbor board, has ordered a new one and it will be installed soon. The H. C. L. on the price of rope, by the way, has gone down since the last one was purchased. The new rope will cost \$75.50 as against \$86.40 paid for the former one, which was stretched nine months ago.
