

OUTRIGGER CLUB WINS SHOWY CANOE EVENT

One of the prettiest races of Regatta Day was the outrigger canoe event taken part in by a crew from the Outrigger club and one from the Hui Nalu. With Dave Center in the bow, the Outrigger club boat won in seven minutes and two seconds, and beat its opponent by several canoe lengths.

The big canoes started from the center of the harbor channel opposite buoy 3, and hit up a terrific pace from that point to the finish line. Never once during the race did the Outrigger club canoe swerve from its course, while the Hui Nalu boat was unfortunate in that it zig-zagged badly and, near the finish, was on the mauka instead of the makai side of the other canoe. Both crews were roundly cheered.

The intermediate race, with six-oared sliding seat barges, was another lively event. It was won by the Healani crew, the time being 15 minutes 24 $\frac{3}{5}$ seconds. The Myrtle crew was second, and was not far behind the blue and white oarsmen at the finish line.
