Two definite dates on the College of Hawaii football schedule were announced last night by Prof. D. L. Crawford, head coach at the institution. The first game will be the annual Freshman-Sophomore contest which is scheduled for October 11 this year. This will be a big event and the sophomore class is certain to make every effort to wipe out the defeat suffered in the flag rush between the two classes Wednesday.

On November 1 the 'varsity team meets the Outrigger Canoe Club eleven which is already organized and at practice. The intervening dates and the dates in November after the Outrigger game, have not yet been filled. Negotiations are now under way with several teams and it is expected that after the meeting of athletic officers in the Hawaiian Department which is scheduled for this week, games with service teams can be secured. Luke Field already has a team which should make a good opponent for the collegians and there is talk of an eleven representing the U. S. S. Beaver.

Practice at the college yesterday was confined to signal drill and instruction in a few new formations. The underclassmen were pretty much all in as a result of the rush and Cooke Field was not crowded by yesterday's squad. But the 'varsity is rounding into shape and will be a formidable team.
