

OUTRIGGER TEAM AND COLLEGE GO TO DRAW SCORE

Failure on the part of Bob Spencer of the College of Hawaii eleven and Canario of the Outriggers to kick goal after each side had made a touchdown resulted in a six to six tie in the first major football contest of the season Saturday afternoon at Alexander field. The touchdowns were made by "Dusky" Brash and J. Hart.

Slow football was played throughout although the Manoa men seemed to have the better teamwork. The surf-riders were unable to play together and their slowness both in the offense and defense showed that more practise is needed. Fumbling was a feature of the contest, both teams coming in for it many times. Offside penalties were also numerous and for these the College of Hawaii suffered heavily.

Second Period

On the first play in the second period the college tried a forward pass, but failed. Then another one was attempted which was successful for 28 yards, Harvey to Hitchcock. With the ball on the 11 yard line to the Outrigger goal, the Green failed to make first down and lost the ball to the canoe men. Canario punted on the first play but the kick was a bad one, going for 15 yards. Harvey ran the ball back six yards. Here the Waikiki team was offside and a penalty gave the Green a chance to score with the oval on the four yard line. Two plunges were held by the Outrigger line and then Dusky Brash took the ball around the left wing for the first touchdown. Bob Spencer failed to kick goal. Score: Outrigger 0, Hawaii 6.

In the third quarter the Outrigger received and after a series of runs and exchanges of punts managed to shove the ball near the Hawaii goal posts. An attempted punt which was blocked by the Outrigger caused the Green to lose the game. With the ball on its 18 yard line the College of Hawaii was penalized for offside on four occasions which gave the Outrigger bunch the ball on the two yard line. Although a short plunge was needed for the two yards the Outrigger had to use all four downs to make the touch. The Green held strong but on the fourth play J. Hart smashed the left line for a score. Canario missed the kick for goal.
