100 yards girls' novice—Mollie Akana (HM), first, time 1:20, breaking Hawaiian record of 1:21 1-5 held by Kathleen Law; Maria C. Lane (HM), second; Hana Kaulani Holt (HM), third.

50 yards Service—L. R. Canario (14SD), first, time 27 flat, 1-5 of a second slower than Hawaiian record; 26 4-5, held by A. Pingry; Sylvester Granrose (CD), second; Lui Kalawalo (14SD), third.

100 yards boys under 18—Pua Kealoha (HM), first, time 56 2-5, breaking own Hawaiian record, 57 2-5, May, 1919; A. E. Minevielle Jr., (O), second; William Pua (H), third.

50 yards girls under 15—Ruth Scudder (O), first, time 31 3-5, breaking Hawaiian record, 34 2-5, held by Edith Kenn; Agnes Auld (P), second; Mollie Akana (HM), third.

440 yards men's open—Norman Ross (IAC), first, time 5:25 4-5 (world's record held by Ludy Langer, 5:17 3-5, Honolulu, February 22, 1917); Warren Kealoha (HM), second; "Stubby" Kruger (SMC), third.

75 yards backstroke novice—John Pua Jr., (H), first, time 54, establishing Hawaiian record; Shigi Matsuguma (P), second; James Whittle (H), third.

50 yards ladies, open—Frances Cowells (SF), first, time 29 1-5, breaking own American record of 29 3-5 and Dorothy Burns' record of 29 4-5, and finishing 1-5 second slower than Fauny Durack's world's record of 29 flat; Edith Kenn (HM), second; "Babe" (Marion) Dowsett (O), third. Agnes Auld (P) finished third but was disqualified for fouling Marion Dowsett.

50 yards boys under 15—James Hakuole (P), first, time 29 4-5; Reuben Kinney (P), second; C. D. Sayres (O), third.

100 yards men's open—Norman Ross (IAC), first, time 54 4-5, world's record, 53 flat, held by Duke Paoa Kahana-moku; Pua Kealoha (HM), second; Warren Kealoha (HM), third.

400 yards girls' relay, 4 girls, 100 yards each—Palama (Elsie Auld, Yoshino Mamiya, Rose Robero and Agnes Auld), first, time 5:38 4-5; Outrigger (Gerd Hjorth, Beatrice Dowsett, Josephine Hopkins and Marion Dowsett), second.
