

Ruth Scudder Defeats Frances Cowells Again In Breaststroke Race

HILLO, November 12—(Special Wire-
less to The Advertiser)—Ruth Scudder,
Outrigger Canoe Club, defeated Fran-
ces Cowells Schroth, famous Califor-
nia swimmer and holder of many rec-
ords, in the 50-yard women's open
breaststroke in the fast time of
:45 4-5s breaking the Hawaiian record
of :46 2-5 made at the recent Honolulu
meet by Cowells.

Norman Ross took first in the 220-
yard men's open with Warren Kealoha
and W. W. Harris Jr., third. The time
was 2:30 4-5s. "Stubby" Kruger
took the 100-yard backstroke, men's
open in 1:14 2-5s, with George C.
Kane, second, and Pua Kealoha third.

Although defeated in the backstroke,
Cowells took first place in the 100-yard
women's open in 1:15 2-5s. She kept
on swimming for another 50 yards and
established an American record for
that distance of 2:04 4-5s. Edith Kenn
of Palama Settlement was second in
the 100-yard. Agnes Auld also of Pa-
lama was third.

Norman Ross won a second victory
by taking the 50-yard men's open in
:25 1-5s, with Warren Kealoha second
and Pua Kealoha third.

Palama Settlement won the girls'
400-yard relay race easily, leading by
75 yards at the finish.

Other races were: 100 yards, girls
local, 50 yards, boys' novice, local, 50
yards girls' novice local and 100 yards,
boys' novice local.

The following are the races sched-
uled for tonight, the final session of
the meet.

50 yards, boys under 18, open.
100 yards, men's open.
50 yards, women's open.
100 yards, breaststroke, men's open.
50 yards backstroke, women's open.
50 yards, boys under 15, open.
440 yards, men's open.
400 yards, Boy Scout relay, 100 yards
each.
400 yards, girls' club relay, 100
yards each.
