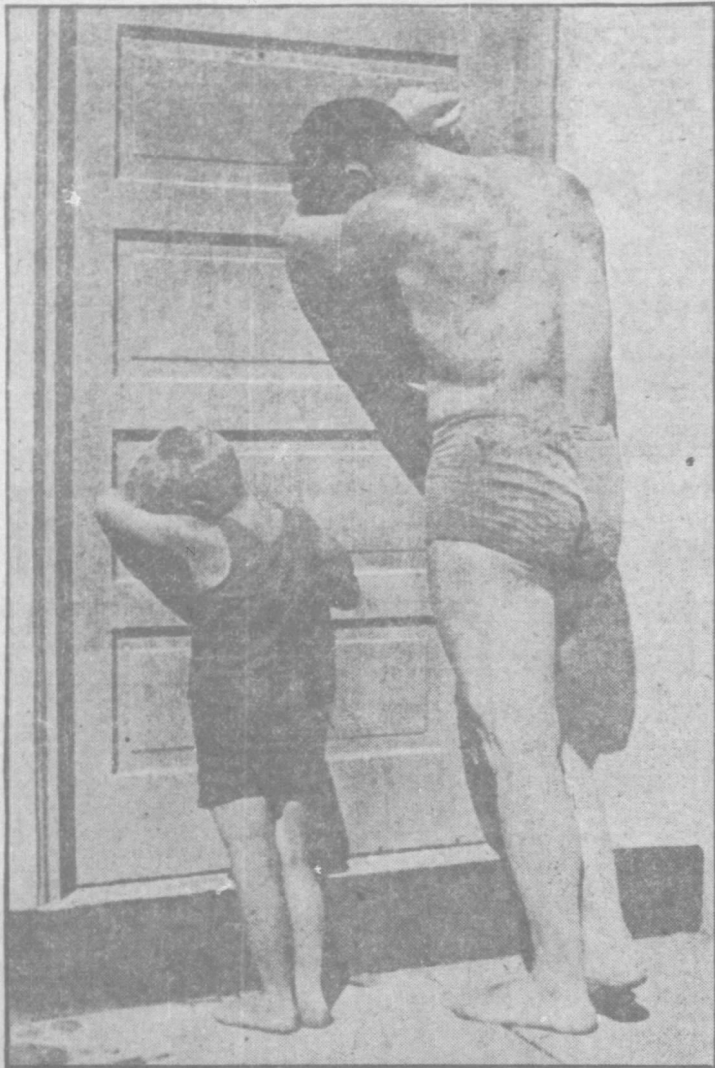


"A COUPLE OF KIDS . . ."
