Waters of Manoa Stream Diverted In Year---Bigelow

Public Works Head Foresees Work Started On Waikiki Drainage Canal By That Time

Within a year the Moana hotel stream will be diverted into the channel which is to be opened up through the Waikiki reclamation district, says Lyman H. Bigelow, superintendent of public works.

Both the Governor and the superintendent are as anxious as the public which frequents Waikiki beach to have the foul waters which flow down this stream from Manoa through the Waikiki swamps to the bathing beach between the Moana hotel and the Outrigger Club diverted.

The superintendent says that one of the first efforts will be to provide an outlet in the Kalia section to permit the waters so diverted to flow into the ocean near the Kewalo flats.

With the stream dry, Waikiki beach will have an opportunity to become a sandy beach as it was in former years, is the opinion of the public works chief.
