

Big Surf Running At Waikiki Beach; Surf Riders Happy

What is regarded as the biggest surf of the year was witnessed at Kaikiki Beach yesterday and the result was that scores of surf riders were out to take advantage of the unusual conditions. During the afternoon "first-break" waves were frequent and many of the riders paddled out beyond the reef.

Sam Kahanamoku and "Smiling" Harry, two Hawaiian boys performed an unusual feat when they caught a "first break" wave and rode it to within 25 feet of the shore by the Outrigger club traveling fully a mile over the water at express train speed.

More big surf is expected this afternoon, tide and wind conditions being excellent.
