

FIVE GRID AFFAIRS SCHEDULED SATURDAY

Honolulu football fans will not want for numbers in the matter of football games next Saturday for a total of five games are on the cards.

There are two Interscholastic league games, one Service league game and two exhibition games.

The game which will probably draw the largest crowd is that billed between McKinley high school and Kamehameha at Kamehameha field.
