

# TEAMS REST WHILE AWAITING WHISTLE TO ACTION SUNDAY AT MOILILI FIELD

## Outriggers and Waikikis Ready To Go In For Crucial Game of Major Season

Outrigger and Waikiki are resting today, in preparation for the big game of Sunday afternoon. There will be not a moment's rest on that day and so the warriors of the opposing heavy-weight teams are taking life easy today in order to store up all energies for the big affray.
