

Arne Borg Is Arranging The Trip, Says Postcard Received From Mrs. Leo

Center Hears From Secretary of Hawaiian A. A. U.;
Card Explains How Harris, Gartley and Kahanamoku
Are Making Trip; General Comment On Sport Doings

Hawaiian swimmers will visit Sweden to perform in a meet there after the Olympic Games in Paris, according to a postcard received yesterday by George D. Center of the Outrigger Canoe Club from Mrs. F. Fullard-Leo, secretary of the Hawaiian A. A. U., who is chaperon to Mariechen Wehselau, the Outrigger swimmer who is on the American team. The card also explains how Dick Gartley, Gay Harris and David Kahanamoku are making the trip.

The card reads as follows:

"We are on board the S. S. America and due to sail in an hour. Mariechen is fine and should come second at least if not first. Have had hard work to get Gay Harris aboard but he has paid his passage over and they have promised to call on him for a rubber or alternate. He has beaten Warren and Luning twice since the finals. Dave Kahanamoku's friends donated \$250 and he goes as a rubber. Stubby Kruger's friends ditto.

"Arne Borg is in town (New York) making up a team to go to Sweden after the Olympic games. It includes most of the Hawaiians.

"Dick Gartley failed, coming fifth in the trials and goes along as passenger. In all we have 14 from Hawaii on board."
