

KIRSCHBAUM AND KEALOHA ARE WINNERS

Mariechen Wehselau Also
Victor in Post Olympic
Meet With the British

Weissmuller Again Beats
Duke in 110 Yards; Sam
Kahanamoku Comes Third

HARROW ON THE
HILL, July 26.—The United States swimmers defeated the British today in a post-Olympic series, in which Hawaiian members of the American squad played a prominent part.

The Americans won first place in nine events and scored 50 points while the British, winning first place in two events, scored 50 points by taking many seconds and thirds.

W. T. Kirschbaum, Hawaii, won the 220 yards breaststroke in 3 minutes 7 4-5 seconds.

Johnny Weissmuller, Chicago, won the 110 yards freestyle for men in 1 minute, 1 1-5 seconds. Duke Kahanamoku was third.

Sam Kahanamoku was a member of the winning American team in the 880 yard relay.

Warren Kealoha, Hawaii, won the 110 yards backstroke in 1 minute, 14 2-5 seconds. Henry Luning, Hawaii, was third.

Mariechen Wehselau, Hawaii, won the 110 yards freestyle for women. She also was a member of the winning American team in the 400 yard relay race.
