

OUTRIGGER WILL MAKE GOOD BID FOR RELAY CUP

Entry Blanks For Punahou Swim Meet Are Available At A. A. U. Offices Now

Entries for the swimming meet at Punahou tank on September 26 close next Monday at 1 p. m. Entry blanks may be obtained at the A. A. U. office, Kauikeolani building. The A. A. U. however, has no connection with the meet beyond giving its sanction, it has been announced.

Although the Outriggers have a number of their men rowing, they are making a strong bid for the relay cup now held by the Hui Nalu and will enter a six-men team. It is quite likely that Dad Center will swim on that.

Pratt, formerly of the Yale relay, will be their anchor man, it is understood. He is expected to give good competition in the 100, too. The novelty event—tub race—seems quite popular. Tubs will be supplied for six starters.

Navy has made special request for men's plunge and this will be submitted to the games committee today. It is likely to be an open event. The diving as one of the Swanzy cup events should not frighten contenders for the cup who are not trained divers.
