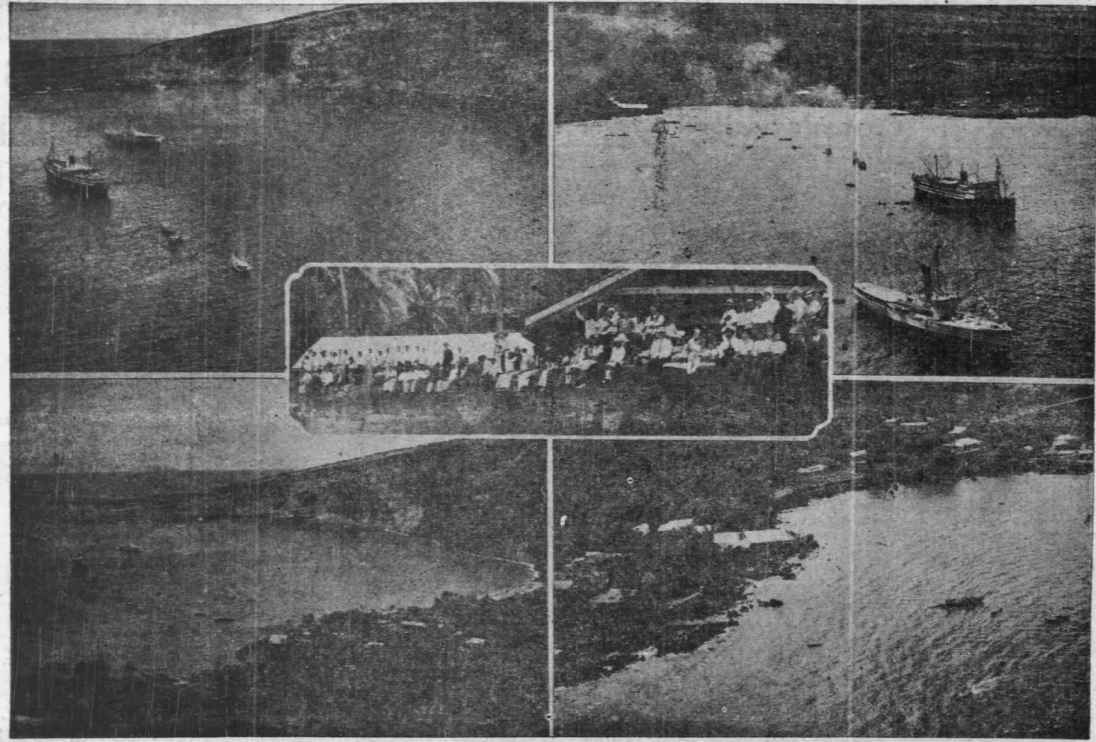


WHERE KONA AND OAHU STRUGGLED FOR SUPREMACY
