

Beach Club Will Expand

Outrigger Plan Made Possible Through Uluniu Giving Up Its Site

Plans to develop the Outrigger Canoe club into one of the smartest and most modern beach clubs in the world were made possible yesterday afternoon when members of the Uluniu Women's Swimming club unanimously consented to vacate their present quarters and move next door to the Royal Hawaiian hotel, so the Outrigger Canoe club can expand waikiki of its present location.

At the present time the Uluniu club has a lease under the B. P. Bishop estate for 15 years. By moving to the location where the Outrigger Canoe club now stands it will be under a sub-lease for 25 years to the Royal Hawaiian hotel, which in turn is under lease from the Queen Emma estate. The Bishop estate has agreed to pay all moving expenses of the Uluniu club, although it has not as yet been decided whether the present club quarters will be moved or new ones erected, Mrs. Arthur L. Andrews, president of Uluniu, said yesterday.
