and up-to-date beach club," Leslie Hicks, member of the special building committee of the Outrigger Canoe club, said last night. "We will keep the beach patrol and water sports and by expanding we will be able to provide for more games and modern facilities for sports."

Hicks said the club plans to make the change about June 1 when the lease from the Queen Emma estate will expire. The new lease with the same estate will be made for 25 years and will allow Outrigger to build on the same sized area, but on the site where the Uluniu club now stands. By moving, the club will have more room for canoes and beach equipment next to the Moana hotel.

The cost has not been estimated as yet, Hicks said, and committees are working on the cost at the present time.

All the present buildings of the Outrigger club will be torn down to allow more room on the beach between Outrigger and the new Uluniu club.
