

Kahanamoku Meet Trials On Tap This Evening

The program to revive swimming interest in Hawaii and return the islands to the place in the aquatic sun it held ten years ago gets underway this evening with the trials of the Duke P. Kahanamoku meet at the Elizabeth Waterhouse memorial tank, Punahou school campus.

The finals will be conducted Thursday evening and a feature then will be an exhibition by Duke himself. The former Olympic champion, who by the way is still an amateur, will swim 50 yards freestyle against time.

And the Duke is fully prepared to give a real exhibition, having been training faithfully the past weeks.

The trials this evening will begin at 7 at the Punahou pool in diving, 220 yards breaststroke open, men; 100 yards freestyle open, women; 220 yards freestyle open, men; 50 yards freestyle, boys under 14; 100 yards freestyle novice, men; 100 yards backstroke open, men; 100 yards freestyle novice, women; 100 yards backstroke open, women; 400 yards relay novice, men; 300 yards medley, novice, men; 300 yards medley relay open, men, and 400 yards relay open, men.

Only four will qualify in the diving and five in each swimming event.

All trials, except diving, will be time affairs, with the fastest five in each event regardless of the positions they finish in their respective heats, qualifying.

BIG ENTRY LIST

The Kahanamoku swims are sponsored by the Associated Students of the University of Hawaii and the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui.

Theodore (Pump) Searle, graduate manager of the University of Hawaii and in charge of the meet, revealed that more than 200 athletes, men and women, are entered in the meet.

Some of the leading clubs entered in the race include Hui Makani, Nuuanu "Y," University of Hawaii, Citywide A.A., Hui Nalu, Roosevelt, Waialua, 40 & 8 and Ft. Kamehameha.

Outside of a team in the old-timers' relay, the Outrigger Canoe club, one of the most powerful swimming organizations of a few years ago, has no entries.
