this indicates a hard fought race in each of the events.

Competition will be particularly close in the 100 yards open and 100 yards novice for men. In the open event, Gilbert Ching of Nuuanu Y, the most recent swimming sensation, and Barney Pung of Hui Makani are looked for to stage a spectacular battle for top honors. The favorite for the novice race is hard to pick as A. Young of Nuuanu Y, who was timed in 50 seconds Tuesday, Clemens and Okumoto of the University and Atherton Guard of Hui Nalu are all capable swimmers and big threats for victory.

Hui Makani has a powerful team in the meet. The Chilton-coached boys will be led by Barney Pung and Noboru Hamada and they are favored to annex the team trophy in many quarters. However, the Nuuanu Y and the University of Hawaii will give them a close battle. The Y'sers this year have developed a fine array of natators and appear ready to crown their first champion since John Komenaka captured the Hawaiian backstroke championship back in 1927.

Lanes have already been assigned to the competitors in each event. The order of diving was also announced yesterday. To speed up things, no preliminary calls for the various events will be made. Only the final call will be used. The coaches have been instructed to have their swimmers ready to start as soon as the preceding event is over.
