Kona Canoe Regatta Is Cancelled

HILO, June 2—Julian Yates
revealed today that the fifth
renewal of the canoe racing
classic at Kailua scheduled for
August 21 had been cancelled
at a meeting of the Kona Civic
club.

The Kona crews have been invincible on home waters since the triumph of the Outrigger Canoe club of Honolulu in 1933.

Cancellation was brought about because of the inability of the committee in charge of the regatta to raise \$4,000 needed to stage the event.

This is a severe blow to the aquatic game on the Big Island. Barge racing in Hilo is dying out, and there is no indication of a revival this year.
