5—1 mile junior six canoe paddle for men.

6— $\frac{1}{4}$  mile surfboard paddling for boys under 17.

7— $\frac{1}{2}$  mile six paddle canoe for women.

8— $\frac{1}{4}$  mile six paddle canoe for boys under 17.

9—1 mile senior four paddle canoe for men.

10— $\frac{1}{2}$  mile surf board paddle relay for men.

Sponsored by the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui, the big canoe and surfboard paddling program gets underway starting at 2 p. m. All races will finish in front of the Ala Wai boathouse.
