

Heen Condemns As Unsafe Outrigger Club Pavilion

The pavilion of the Outrigger Canoe club, famous Waikiki landmark, has been condemned as unsafe, it was announced yesterday by A. W. Heen, city-county building superintendent.

Heen said the building was a menace to the public because of the depredations of termites and that social functions may not be held in the structure.

"The pavilion is in a very serious state of disrepair because of termites and my department has

forbidden its use for social functions," Heen said. "The club has been instructed to repair the structure or to tear it down."

The Outrigger club has been a famous recreation spot at the beach for many years. The lease held by the club from the Queen Emma estate expired June 30. A drive for funds is being conducted to keep the club going. Also under consideration are plans for tearing down the pavilion and constructing modern quarters.
