Other Islands Expected
To Send Candidates
For "Boy Champ"

OFFICIALS and order of events of the Duke P. Kahanamoku Outdoor swimming meet were announced yesterday by Theodore Searle, president of the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui, which is sponsoring the event August 18 and 20.

In an endeavor to make the meet an outstanding one, the Olympic Club swimmers of San Francisco have been invited to compete in the meet and several feature events have been arranged.

Among the feature events will be the surfboard water polo match between the oldtimers of the Outrigger Canoe club and the Hui Nalu and a water polo match between Hawaii and the Olympic club. Also a special 100 yards freestyle for boys and girls under 16 years of age. It is expected that the other islands will send a swimmer or two to compete in this event which will crown the "boy champion of the islands."

The Olympic clubbers will participate in events that are usually held in intercollegiate meets.
