

Outrigger Club Board To Meet

Final disposition of the Outrigger Canoe club pavilion, condemned Friday by the city building department, will be decided next Tuesday night, when members of the executive board will discuss whether the structure will be torn down, or renovated at an approximate expense of \$500, Lewis E. Haehnlen, club manager, announced yesterday.

According to Haehnlen, the pavilion floor and underpinnings are in excellent condition, but the three cross beams which support the roof are termite ridden and must be replaced.

"We will hold no social functions on the dance floor until the board has met to decide on a final course of action," Haehnlen declared. "Although the pavilion has been condemned, the rest of the building is in perfect condition."
