

Outrigger Club Repairs Building

Repairs to the condemned Outrigger Club pavilion will be started today, it was announced last night at the last meeting of the club's 1936-37 executive board.

The pavilion was condemned two weeks ago by Building Superintendent Heen, after it was discovered three of the main cross beams of the building were termite-ridden.

Contractor George Freitas has been awarded a contract of doing the repair work at a cost estimated at approximately \$500.
