

Kamaainas Meet Friday To Set Swimming Plans

Final plans for the Duke P. Kahanamoku outdoor swimming meet to be staged by the Kamaaina Beachcombers' hui August 18 and 20 will be decided Friday night when members of the progressive club hold a chop sui dinner.

The organization will bring a group of swimmers from the Olympic club of San Francisco to compete with locals in the big meet.

The addition of several feature races and two women's events has been announced. The wahines' races will be a 100 yard freestyle open on the opening day of the meet, August 18, followed by a 100 yard breaststroke event August 20.

Feature races include a father and son relay for members of the Hui Nalu and Outrigger Canoe club and a precision swim among young swimmers who have been taught their stuff by Duke Kahanamoku.
