WHO will win the 1937 baseball championship of Schofield Barracks may be answered at the inland post this afternoon when three games are played. Two of the games on today's triple-header show the 21st Infantry Gimlets and the 27th Infantry Wolfhounds, the clubs tied for top honors, against teams who beat the league-leaders in upset victories last round. A double-header is also scheduled for play Sunday afternoon.

This afternoon the 21st Infantry Gimlets meet the Staff Tigers at Gimlet Park while the 27th Infantry Wolfhounds pay a visit to the 3rd Engineers at Ralston Field. The 19th Infantry Chicks will meet the 18th Pursuit Group Fliers at Strubling Field in the third game of the triple bill.
