ARE EXPECTED

Men Divers To Show Instead of Women At Titular Meet; Entries Close

Over 70 entries have already been received for the second program of the Hawaiian outdoor swimming championship series which is slated for 4:30 p. m. Saturday at the Waikiki war memorial pool. No admission is charged to the events.

Victor Ligda, in charge of the three program meet, stated that over 100 should compete this Saturday. The entry list for the second splash is closing at 6 p. m. today at the Central "Y" building.



Included in list already entered is the cream of the local swimming world. Those who competed and starred in the first meet held last Saturday are all raring to go again.

For individual honors, for which prizes are being obtained, Mildred Slight Hooper is leading with 15

points for women, while Maurice Furusho, Desha (Hilo) and Alvarez are tied for five points each for men.

To Get Trophies

An attempt is being made to secure a trophy for the team collecting the most points during the series. To date the Harbor Defense has amassed 9 points. The Makani have nine digits to their credit, but they haven't a chance for the team trophy because of withdrawing from competition.

For the women's team honors, the Outrigger Canoe club is far ahead with 22 markers. The unattached forces have collected six points.

Ligda announced that the women's platform diving event for this Saturday's program has been cancelled because of the lack of entries and interest. In its place will be an exhibition by men who are competing in the diving event a week later.

Trials Here

Because of the large entry list in the 440 yard freestyle for men and the 220 yard backstroke for men, both Hawaiian championship affairs, trials will be necessary in these two events.

The trials will be held at 4:30 p. m. Friday at the natatorium.
