

Big Entry List For Swim Meet on Saturday

Trial Heats in Two Events For Friday Afternoon At Natatorium

DUE TO the large number of entries in the second meet of the Hawaiian Open swimming championships for the 440 freestyle men and the 220 yard backstroke men it will be necessary to run off trials for these events Friday at 4:30 at the War Memorial Natatorium. The finals will be staged during the meet that is to be held Saturday at 4:30. There will be no admission charged the spectators for the meet and the public is urged to attend.

The Waiakua A. C. who it will be remembered was forced not to compete in the last meet because of a misunderstanding of the starting time, will be at the meet to recoup their losses. Many of the swimmers had their hearts set on some of the events and were greatly disappointed when informed of their mistake. Because of this the swimming fans can be sure to see the Waiakua team swim at their best.

The platform diving for women has been canceled because there was a lack of interest and a decided lack of entries for the event. There will, however, be an exhibition of diving from the tower by some of the men divers, they are doing this at a considerable sacrifice.

The team scores, counted up adding the events other than the Hawaiian championships find the Outrigger Women's team far ahead of their nearest competitors with 22 digits. The men's teams are to date fairly even; the Hui Makani and Harbor Defense tied with 9 apiece. However, the Hui Makani are out of the swims and therefore their points cannot mount higher than they are now.
