To help stimulate interest in canoe racing here, the Inter-Island steamship company has offered to transport koa logs for building the Hawaiian crafts, from the other islands for local clubs, free of charge.

Upon hearing reports that several local clubs intend to build racing canoes, the steamship company offered their services and facilities to the organizations gratis.

The canoe races held in Kona this year in an effort to revive the ancient Hawaiian games proved such a success that the event will be made an annual affair.

With this in mind local swimming and canoe clubs—Outriggers, Queen Surfers, and the Hui Nalus—are reported to be seriously considering building canoes for next year's races.
